## Leading vs Freelancing??

As a leader, you will be allocated a "family" with a missus/mister and 6 kids. Your family is your crew for the week. As a leader, from 7am to 11pm you look after your kids - get them changed, give them breakkie and play with them. Leading is full-on but incredibly incredibly rewarding. Sometimes the best way to learn is by being thrown in the deep end!

Freelancers have a more floating job, rather than a specific family. They do stuff like look after kids who need special attention, make lunches, set up activities and play lifeguards at swimming pools. If you think leading sounds a bit intense, freelancing is an awesome way to ease into camps. You don't get as much kid time but you get to hang out with other freelancers which is just as awesome.

**2. Please come and help out at The Rotary Craft Fair on the Oak Lawn at UWA**

It's on Sunday 26th October on the Oak Lawn at UWA. Basically Rotary gives us a big donation towards camp in exchange for UCFK volunteers who help them set-up and pack-up their Craft Fair. So come down for 3 hours, either 6am-9am or 3.30pm-6.30pm. Unlike previous years, its not during exams so you have no excuse! Remember, it's stuff like this that makes camps happen!

**3. Get a WORKING WITH CHILDRENS CHECK**

If you are a first time camper it is absolutely essential that you get one of these before camps- it's just like a Police Clearance, and required by law. To get one go to your nearest Post Office, pick up a form, get someone from UCFK to sign it, and take it back to the Post Office with \$10. They take 4 weeks to process and their office is closed over Xmas/ New Years so please go get one now!

UCFK has some pre-signed children's check forms in the UCFK Office (Level 2 Student Guild) to make your life even easier. So come pick one up between 12-2pm from Mon - Thurs in the week before study break starts (no one will be there in study break/exams) or contact someone on committee.

If you came on camps last year you don't need another one, they are valid for 3 years.

**4. Wait for a letter letting you know what camp you are on and what role you are**

**5. Please keep the afternoon of SUNDAY 7TH DECEMBER free for a pre-camp meeting.**

You'll get to meet everyone on your camp, talk to past campers, find out exactly what's involved, what you do everyday etc. So keep this afternoon free, especially if you haven't done camps before!
